LIQUIDATOR'S FIRST CLAIMS REPORT & RECOMMENDATION & APPLICATION FOR ORDER APPROVING SAME

Comes now Petitioner, as Liquidator of the above-captioned insurance company (TISRRG), by and through the undersigned counsel, and files herewith his First Claims Report & Recommendation and applies to the Court for an Order approving the Liquidator's undisputed claim determinations specified herein.

This application is made pursuant to the South Carolina Insurers Rehabilitation and Liquidation Act, S.C. Code Ann. §§ 38-27-10 et seq., specifically, S.C. Code Ann. § 38-27-620(a) (2015), wherein the Liquidator is required to review all claims duly filed in the liquidation proceedings, make such further investigation as he deems necessary, and submit a claims report to the Court containing his claim recommendations.

In support of his report, recommendation and application, the Liquidator would respectfully show the following:

- 1. On April 13, 2020, the Court entered an Order Commencing Liquidation Proceedings & Granting an Injunction & Automatic Stay of Proceedings regarding TISRRG.
- 2. Between the Liquidation Date of April 13, 2020, and October 31, 2020, the latter being the Claims Bar Date, the Liquidator issued approximately four hundred forty-nine (449)

Notices of Liquidation and Proof of Claim (POC) forms, with instructions to policyholders, third-party claimants and other potential claimants and/or creditors of TISRRG.

- 3. On June 3, 2020, notice of the liquidation was published in The Indianapolis Star, informing interested parties of the liquidation proceedings, including contact information and instructions for the timely filing of a POC. Additionally, on June 11, 2020, notice of the liquidation was published in The New York Times, a newspaper of nationwide circulation.
- 4. On or before the Bar Date of October 31, 2020, the Liquidator received thirty-nine (39) timely-filed POCs. One (1) timely-filed POC was subsequently withdrawn by the claimant, leaving thirty-eight (38) remaining timely-filed POCs. The Liquidator also received eleven (11) late-filed claims.
- 5. Thirty-two (32) claims have now been completely adjudicated. All remaining POCs received, totaling seventeen (17), remain under evaluation.
- 6. Attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein is a Schedule listing the names and addresses of fifteen (15) claimants holding a class 2 claim as defined by S.C. Code Ann. § 38-27-610(2) (2015), the POC number assigned by the Liquidator and the valuation of the claim proposed by the Liquidator.
- 7. Attached hereto as Exhibit B is a Schedule listing the names and addresses of seventeen (17) claimants holding a class of claim subordinate to class 2, as the class code is defined by S.C. Code Ann. § 38-27-610 (2015). These claims were adjudicated as to priority class only, as the Liquidator expects distributions to class 2 to be less than 100 percent.
- 8. In further support of this report, recommendation and application, the Liquidator has attached as Exhibit C, the affidavit of Michael J. FitzGibbons, Special Deputy Liquidator.

WHEREFORE, the Liquidator prays the Court issue an Order approving this first Claims

Report and recommendation, with the actual distribution to be determined at the appropriate time in accordance with S.C. Code Ann. §§ 38-27-610 & -630 (2015), as well as such other relief as the Court deems just and proper.

Michael J. FitzGibbons, being first duly sworn, deposes and says as follows:

- 1. I am the Special Deputy Liquidator of Transportation Insurance Services Risk Retention Group, Inc. ("TISRRG"). I was appointed to my position by the Liquidator, Raymond G. Farmer, former Director of the South Carolina Department of Insurance, which designation was approved by the Court on April 13, 2020.
 - 2. I am over 21 years of age and suffer no legal disability.
- 3. By virtue of my appointment as Special Deputy Liquidator, I have been actively and personally involved in the liquidation of TISRRG at all times since it was placed into liquidation, including the matters addressed in this Affidavit. My responsibilities as the Special Deputy Liquidator include supervision and oversight of and direct involvement in the liquidation process. I am familiar with the claims process and with the claims that have been filed. Therefore, I have personal knowledge of the matters addressed in this Affidavit.
- 4. The claims process has included the following components, each and every one of which has been followed:
 - a. Notice of TISRRG's liquidation was given in accordance with S.C. Code Ann. §

- 38-27-410(a) (2015).
- b. In accordance with S.C. Code Ann. § 38-27-410(b) (2015), the notice specified that the last date to file a timely proof of claim with the Liquidator was October 31, 2020. Proofs of claim had to be postmarked no later than 5:00 P.M. Eastern Time on that date to be considered timely.
- c. The Liquidator's Proof of Claim (POC) forms are in compliance with S.C. Code Ann. § 38-27-550(a) (2015) and provided notice of the liquidation of TISRRG in accordance with S.C. Code Ann. § 38-27-410(b) (2015).
- d. As the duly-appointed Special Deputy Liquidator, I have considered each of the thirty-two (32) POCs subject to this Claims Report, in accordance with the requirements of the South Carolina Insurers Rehabilitation and Liquidation Act, S.C. Code Ann. §§ 38-27-10 et seq.
- e. I am administering the claims process. I engaged Glynloen Consulting with the responsibility to make recommendations to the Liquidator as to the validity, valuation and priority of each POC. The Liquidator and/or his duly-appointed Special Deputy then independently approve or deny these recommendations, in whole or in part, and submits the same to this Court for approval.
- f. Each POC subject to this Claims Report contains the necessary claim file documentation for the Liquidator's recommendation thereon.
- g. To the extent this Claims Report includes claims that were denied in whole or in part, notice of such denial complying with S.C. Code Ann. § 38-27-580(a) (2015) was provided to the affected claimants and either no timely objection was made by the affected claimants or the objection was resolved by mutual agreement.

- 5. I am submitting this Affidavit in support of the Liquidator's First Claims Report & Recommendation & Application for Order Approving Same ("Report & Recommendation & Application"), which pertains to fifteen (15) Class 2 claims, and seventeen (17) claims subordinate to Class 2, as prescribed by S.C. Code Ann. §§ 38-27-610 & -620 (2015).
- 6. Between the entry of the Liquidation Order on April 13, 2020 and October 31, 2020, I caused to be issued approximately four hundred forty-nine (449) Notices of Liquidation and Proof of Claim (POC) forms, with instructions to policyholders, third-party claimants, and/or other potential claimants and creditors of TISRRG.
- 7. On June 3, 2020, I caused to be published Notice of the liquidation in The Indianapolis Star, informing interested parties of the liquidation proceedings and including contact information and instructions for the timely filing of a claim.
- 8. On June 11, 2020, I caused to be published Notice of the liquidation in The New York Times, a newspaper of nationwide circulation, informing interested parties of the liquidation proceedings and including contact information and instructions for the timely filing of a claim.
- 9. Thirty-two (32) claims have now been fully adjudicated. All remaining POCs received, totaling seventeen (17), are presently under evaluation.
- 10. Attached to the Report & Recommendation & Application and incorporated by reference as Exhibit A is a listing of the names and addresses of fifteen (15) claimants with Class 2 claims as defined in S.C. Code Ann. § 38-27-610(2) (2015), the POC number assigned and the Liquidator's valuation and recommendation pursuant to S.C. Code Ann. § 38-27-620 (2015).
- 11. Attached to the Report & Recommendation & Application and incorporated by reference as Exhibit B is a listing of names and addresses of seventeen (17) claimants holding a class of claim subordinate to class 2, as the class code is defined by S.C. Code Ann. § 38-27-610

(2015). These claims were adjudicated as to priority class only as I expect distributions to class 2 to be less than 100 percent.
